UBER COLLEGE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ('MOU') is made at Hubli, Karnataka, India on this 12th day of November 2020 by and between:

Deshpande Educational Trust, a charitable trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act 1882, and having its principal office at Airport Road, Hubballi, Karnataka 580030 India, (hereinafter "**Deshpande Skilling**") duly represented by its Chief Operating Officer, Mr. P.N. Navak which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the meaning or context thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns

AND

"**KLE Society's G I Bagewadi Arts, Science And Commerce College, Nipani**" having its presence in District Belagum, Pin code - 591237 offering technical diploma / under graduation courses for B.Com, BA, B.Sc., B.Ed., BBA, Diploma represented by its **Prof. Shankarmurthy KN** (hereinafter referred to as "**Partner College**", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns)

AND

DESHPANDE SKILLING and **The PARTNER COLLEGE** are hereinafter collectively referred to as '**Parties**' and individually as a '**Party**'.

WHEREAS:

1. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** a "**not for profit**" trust, an impact unit of **Deshpande Foundation, India**, and a training partner of **National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC)**, involved in the activity of conducting residential employability skills training programs for graduates of rural and semi urban colleges at its skilling campus in Hubballi, and providing placement assistance to its students. **Deshpande Skilling** is desirous to bring about rural transformation by building employability skills among graduate youth from rural and semi urban colleges and assist them earn their first employment in the formal sector. **Deshpande Skilling** wishes to admit job seeking students who pass out of college, but have failed to acquire the required skills to earn employment to its skilling program.
2. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** collects a fee from the students enrolling for the residential skilling program with the objective of ensuring ownership of the student in the exercise. The quantum of fees forms only part of the cost of the activity.

DESHPANDE SKILLING neither earns nor is desirous of any profit from the activity of skilling.

3. The PARTNER COLLEGE is desirous to see more of its students succeed to earn their employment in reputed organizations and also enhance its own placement record.
4. The two parties, DESHPANDE SKILLING and The PARTNER COLLEGE seek to partner with each other, to achieve the common goal of skilling graduate pass outs, and thereby succeed in starting their working career.
5. The principal and staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE will identify and recommend to DESHPANDE SKILLING names of final year students of the college who are inclined to join a job after graduating but are lacking in skills critical to earn their placement.
6. The principal and staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE will also identify deserving students who are financially challenged for concession in fees, and recommend same to DESHPANDE SKILLING.
7. DESHPANDE SKILLING will select students from the list recommended by the PARTNER COLLEGE and offers to admit, train and provide placement assistance to students who join the various programs.
8. DESHPANDE SKILLING offers skill training and placement assistance to students of many colleges and will form training cohorts of students from multiple colleges. Students of the PARTNER COLLEGE will be provided with common facilities and training services as all other students in training.
9. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will offer concessional fee structure to the financially challenged students as per recommendation of the PARTNER COLLEGE principal. The total concession amount available to the students of the PARTNER COLLEGE will depend on the number of admissions, and will be mutually decided by the two parties.
10. The Parties recognize the capabilities and resources that each party brings, and agrees to use their best efforts to bring together those capabilities and resources to collaborate for the purpose of supporting skill-based training with DESHPANDE SKILLING. The PARTNER COLLEGE will support by identifying and counselling job seeking students to take benefit best from the skilling program. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will support by skilling and placing students of the PARTNER COLLEGE and enhance its placement rate.

11. DESHPANDE SKILLING will work with the PARTNER COLLEGE to build a mindset of preparing early to earn a placement and start career among select students of the partner college. The 2 parties will agree on an annual activity calendar that could include group counselling and Q&A session, interaction with Alumni of the college who have been successful, remote classes for students, and any other activities that could give students awareness and exposure.
12. DESHPANDE FOUNDATION will also extend invitation to staff of the PARTNER COLLEGE to attend trainings and workshops that it will conduct on Skills Development for employability and other such areas that can contribute to enhancing placement record of the PARTNER COLLEGE.

The Parties are therefore entering into this MOU to record the terms and conditions of this collaboration. **DESHPANDE SKILLING** and **THE PARTNER COLLEGE** have agreed to enter into this MOU to record their present state of agreement in principle in respect of the **UBER College Partnership Program**.

NOW IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

This collaboration between DESHPANDE SKILLING and THE PARTNER COLLEGE will be to impart skill training and provide placement assistance to select students of "THE PARTNER COLLEGE" to be able earn their first employment. The objective of this partnership is to facilitate rural transformation by getting rural youth into productive employment, and to enhance the placement record of the partner college.

Roles & Responsibilities of PARTNER COLLEGE:

1. Party would enter in MOU for the DESHPANDE SKILLING's "**UBER College Partnership Program**" for Skill development Training for interested students of The PARTNER COLLEGE.
2. PARTNER COLLEGE will support the program by recommending about 30 most suitable students of the college each year for the residential skilling program for graduate students conducted by DESHPANDE SKILLING at its Skilling campus.
3. PARTNER COLLEGE will recommend students from BA / B.Com/B.Sc. / BBA / BCA / B.Ed. /Technical Diploma / ITI streams only.
4. PARTNER COLLEGE will apply adequate justification for recommendation of each student for admission. The recommendation will be an informed decision that the student would benefit from the skilling program and the student and his/her family has a high "need for job".

5. PARTNER COLLEGE will avoid recommending candidates who already possess good employability skills, or candidates who are extremely low on employability skills or candidates who are not keen to start their working career immediately.
6. PARTNER COLLEGE will permit and facilitate representatives of DESHPANDE FOUNDATION to interact with the recommended students and their parents at the college for counselling before admission to the program.
7. The PARTNER COLLEGE will not have objection to DESHPANDE SKILLING collecting a part of the cost of skilling each student, in the form of fellowship fees from the students.
8. The PARTNER COLLEGE will identify and recommend reduction fellowship fees for selected candidates from the list of recommended candidates based on family of the specific candidate. The maximum recommendation for reduction in fellowship fees for any candidate will not exceed 50 % of the fees. The cumulative discount amount recommended by the Partner colleges for the year will not exceed the limit mutually agreed between DESHPANDE SKILLING and the PARTNER COLLEGE.
9. The PARTNER COLLEGE will permit DESHPANDE SKILLING to list the PARTNER COLLEGE as its partner on its Web Site and other communication channels.

Roles & Responsibilities of DESHPANDE SKILLING:

1. DESHPANDE SKILLING will enter into MOU with the PARTNER COLLEGE and work closely with the college to develop student mindset for "preparing for placement" early and to enhance placement record of the Partner College by skilling select students at its residential skilling center and provide them placement assistance to earn their job offer.
2. DESHPANDE SKILLING will develop a calendar of interactions with select students of the partner college to develop awareness of job roles, competencies for job roles and a mindset for preparing for job roles right from their first year in college.
3. DESHPANDE SKILLING will counsel students recommended by the college and assess their trainability and need for job before admitting the students for the residential skilling program.

4. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide the skill training to students of the partner college at its residential skilling facility as per academic plan of the specific program into which they are admitted.
5. DESHPANDE SKILLING will offer placement assistance to students of the Partner College admitted to its skilling program. Every student will be provided with multiple opportunities for placement process of different companies.
6. DESHPANDE SKILLING will with employer organizations to understand current and future skill requirements of employers and also to invite employers to provide opportunity to fellows of the skilling program for openings in their organizations.
7. THE PARTNER COLLEGE will be branded in DESHPANDE SKILLING's program website and other relevant platforms which are viewed by community of employers.
8. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide updates about the progress of students of the partner college to the placement officer and principal of the partner college. The partner college will also be updated about the job offers received by its students.
9. DESHPANDE SKILLING retains its right to charge the students skill trainings.
10. DESHPANDE SKILLING will communicate that the partner college can extend to its financially challenged students during the first week of January each year.
11. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide training completion certificates to all such students who have successfully completed the training. The certificate will bear the logo of NSDC and DESHPANDE SKILLING.
12. DESHPANDE SKILLING will provide placement assistance to students of the program thru its in-house Placement Assistance Cell or its placement partners.
13. DESHPANDE SKILLING will explore non-residential skills training program for diploma students at your premises

This MOU will commence on the date written herein below ("the Effective Date") and shall be valid ("the Term"). Each Party shall, at any time during the Term, be entitled to immediately terminate this MOU by giving written notice to the other party. If such other Party materially breaches this MOU or if such other Party or its representatives engage in activities that non-defaulting Party reasonably believes pose a risk to its reputation or goodwill, terminates above mentioned MOU

Confidentiality

The Parties acknowledge that, in the course of their negotiations under this MOU, it may be necessary for one Party to provide documentation, technical and business information and/or intellectual property, in whatever form recorded (collectively, "Confidential Information"), to

the other Party. All Confidential Information provided or disclosed by either Party hereunder shall remain the property of the furnishing party, and shall be held in strict confidence by the receiving Party, unless the furnishing Party otherwise consents in writing or unless disclosure of such Confidential Information is required by the applicable laws.

Any disputes or differences which may arise between the Parties out of, in relation to or in connection with this MoU, or for the breach thereof shall be settled by arbitration. Each Party hereto shall be entitled to appoint 1 (one) arbitrator and the 2 (two) arbitrators so appointed shall appoint the presiding arbitrator. The Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modifications shall govern the arbitration thereof. The venue of arbitration shall be at Hubballi, India and language of arbitration shall be English language.

Applicable Law & Jurisdiction

Any action/dispute/claim arising out of or related to this MoU shall be governed by the laws of India and the courts at Hubballi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of all such actions/disputes/claims arising out of this MoU.

Notices

Any notice, or other communication under this MoU shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been effectively served if sent by personal delivery or courier or by registered prepaid mail and addressed to the Parties at their respective addresses set forth hereinbefore (or at such other address as a Party may specify by notice to the other).

Miscellaneous

Entire Agreement: The Parties have read and understood this MoU, along any document referred to in this MoU and annexure constitute the complete and exclusive statement of MoU between them with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all proposals, representations, understandings including any prior agreement whether oral or written and all other communications between them relating thereto.

Heading: The headings of terms and conditions herein contained are inserted for convenience of reference only and are not intended to be a part of or to affect the meaning or interpretation of any of the terms and conditions of this MoU.





Variation: No variation or amendments shall be effective unless the same is in writing signed by the Parties or their authorized representatives.

Counter Parts: This MoU may be signed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MoU") is entered into on 24/06/2022 and shall be effective from 24/06/2022

BY AND BETWEEN:

Sorting Hat Technologies Private Limited, a private company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 bearing CIN U72200KA2015PTC082063 and having its registered office at Maruti Infotech Centre, 3rd Floor, A-Block, Domlur, Koramangala Inner Ring Road, Bangalore-560071, Karnataka, India, A part of **Unacademy, Bengaluru** (hereinafter referred to as "**Company**", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to include its legal representatives and permitted assigns) of the **FIRST PART**;

AND

KLE Society's G. I. Bagewadi Arts, Science and Commerce College, Nipani with its campus at Nipani herein after referred to as "**College**", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, be deemed to include its legal representatives and permitted assigns of the **SECOND PART**;

The Company and the College shall thereafter, as the context may require, individually be referred to as a "**Party**" and collectively be referred to as the "**Parties**".

THE PARTIES TO THIS MoU HERE BY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. SCOPE

- 1.1. The College is an educational institution recognized under law, providing education to students for various disciplines.
- 1.2. The Company owns and operates a technology platform which provides among other services, test preparation and on line learning called www.unacademy.com or the UnacademyApp
- 1.3. The College is desirous of engaging with the Company for various collaborative activities as given in this MOU; The Company may
 - 1.3.1. Conduct Webinars to create awareness about career opportunities in the subject or field that the students at the College are interested in;
 - 1.3.2. Conduct technical workshops, advance technologies workshops and campus placement workshops.
- 1.4. The details of the Activities shall be mutually decided between the Parties and confirmed via email or by a separate agreement or contract as required.
- 1.5. The College shall provide the contact details of the students, with the required consents, who need to be rolled in the webinars and workshops to the Company, or who are meritorious.

- 1.6. The Parties agree, in the event the Parties decide to confirm details of the Activities via Email, such Email shall be a valid and binding on both Parties, along with corresponding terms and condition for each Activity.
- 1.7. The Parties agree that this MoU is being entered purely for collaborative purposes without any expectation of any monetary compensation.
- 1.8. In the event the College recognizes any students who are meritorious, upon mutual agreement between the Parties, the Company shall offer special discounts for those individuals. It is hereby clarified that the discounts can be availed directly by those students who purchase a subscription on the Platform and the Company shall not collect or process any payments to the College at any point of time. The discounted subscriptions will be provided by the Company subject to the College sharing the requested details of the individuals with the Company. The Company may even share a unique code that the student may have to input at the time of availing the subscription in order to avail the special discounts. The details and terms and conditions for any Activity involving such discounted subscription shall be shared via Email or a separate agreement or contract.

2. TERM

This MoU shall commence on the Effective Date and shall continue until 24/06/2023.

3. TERMINATION

- 3.1 Either Party shall have the right to terminate this MOU by providing 30 (Thirty) days written notice in the event that any Party materially breaches its obligations under this MOU:
 - a. In a manner that is irremediable; or
 - b. Fails to remedy a remediable breach within 30 days after being put on notice of such breach by the non-breaching Party; or
 - c. Undergoes a "bankruptcy event", as such term is conventionally understood or for convenience.
- 3.2 Upon termination of this MOU and thereafter, neither Party shall provide to any beneficiary or third party or the public at large, the impression that the association between the Parties is continuing or allow such impression to be created.
- 3.3 Notwithstanding the termination of this MoU, the terms contain ed in Clause 4 below, in relation to confidentiality and non-disclosure, shall survive for a period of 2 (Two) years from the date of termination of this MoU.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE

- 4.1 Each Party hereby acknowledges that, based on the Party's past or current relationship with the other Party such Party has had access to, or may have access to and become acquainted with the Confidential Information (*as defined below*) of the other Party. Each Party hereby covenants and agrees that it shall not, in any fashion, form or manner, unless previously and specifically consented to in writing by the other Party, either directly or indirectly use, divulge, transmit or otherwise disclose or cause to be used, divulged, transmitted or otherwise disclosed to any person, firm, partnership, corporation or the entity now existing or hereafter created, in any manner whatsoever (other than to its directors, officers, employees and advisors and other than as required by law), any of the disclosing Party's Confidential Information of any kind, nature or description. Each Party hereby further acknowledges and agrees that the sale or unauthorized use, transmission or other disclosure of any of the disclosing Party's Confidential Information which is in their possession constitutes unfair competition and the receiving Party covenants and agrees that it shall not engage in any unfair competition with the disclosing Party. The foregoing provisions shall not be construed to prevent the receiving Party from making use of or

disclosing information that is in the public domain through no fault of receiving Party; provided, however, specific information shall not be deemed to be in the public domain merely because it is encompassed by some general information that is published or in the public domain. The foregoing provisions shall also not be construed as preventing Company from reasonable and bonafide efforts to promote the Company using Personality's Services.

- 4.2 "Confidential Information" shall mean (a) this MOU and any information which is disclosed by any Party to the other Party pursuant to, or in connection with this MOU (whether orally or in writing and whether or not such information is expressly stated to be confidential); (b) any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with this MOU or the resolution of such claim or dispute; (c) any information or materials prepared by or for the Parties or its representatives that contain or otherwise reflect, or are generated from the Confidential Information; (d) in case of the Company, any trade secrets, information, ideas, concepts, processes, techniques, or any other Intellectual Property, any information or data relating to the affairs of any Party including any project, work in progress, reports, statistics, summaries, records, future business, revenue projections, operational or financial plans, financing or personnel matters, information relating to present or future works, views, subscribers, clients, customers, employees, key persons engaged by the Company. Confidential Information shall not include any information in public domain, provided, however, specific information shall not be deemed to be in the public domain merely because it is encompassed by some general information that is published or in the public domain.

5. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- 5.1 Each Party hereby represents and warrants to the other Party that it has the legal capability to grant the rights under this MoU and to satisfy its obligations and responsibilities hereunder.
- 5.2 Other than as specifically provided herein, each Party warrants that it shall not represent to any third party that its acting on behalf of the other Party and in no case shall each Party create or allow the creation of the impression that the other Party has any director or indirect relationship with or liability to the beneficiaries or such other third party.
- 5.3 Each Party ('Indemnifying Party') agrees that it shall, at its own expense, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other Party and the other Party's officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents, respective directors, trustees and assigns from and against any and all direct liability (including but not limited to liabilities, judgments, damages, losses, claims, costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees and expenses) and any other direct loss that may occur, or arise from or relate to malfeasance, misfeasance or deliberate negligence or breach of any representations or warranties by the Indemnifying Party, in the performance of the Indemnifying Party's material obligations under this MOU.
- 5.4 To the extent permitted by applicable law, in no event shall either Party be liable for any special, indirect, consequential, exemplary or incidental damages, however caused to the other Party, arising out of or relating to this MoU.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 6.1 Each Party acknowledges the intellectual property rights of any kind, including but not limited to copyright, patent rights, design rights, service marks, trademarks, logos, titles, slogans, property rights and any other rights, held by the other Party. The Parties undertake that neither of them shall claim any right, title and interest in the intellectual property rights of the other Party.
- 6.2 During the Term, each Party grants the other Party a limited, non-exclusive, royalty-free right under this MOU to use its name and logo for the purposes of public relations and promoting the association between the Parties under this MOU, including without limitation, promoting over social media platforms, promotional material as approved by the other Party in writing and all related collateral.

Each Party shall obtain the other Party's approval before using the other Party's name and logo in public relations, promotional and related communications as provided herein, it being agreed by the other Party that such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed. Further, it is clarified and agreed among the Parties that any such approval granted shall sustain during the Term for repeated use of such approving Party's name and logo in similar public relations, promotional and related communications for purposes of the Program defined herein.

6.3 The Parties agree that subject to the licenses granted hereinabove, any intellectual property rights created by either Party in the course of giving effect to this MOU shall be owned by the Party that creates the same.

7. GOVERNING LAW, DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND JURISDICTION

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India. Any dispute under this MOU shall be resolved by arbitration by a sole arbitrator appointed in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, in Bengaluru, India. The courts of Bengaluru, India shall have jurisdiction over this MOU.

8. MISCELLANEOUS

This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the Agreement and supersedes all prior written agreements and understandings, both written and oral, between the Parties with respect to the Agreement. This MOU shall be binding in all respects and shall govern the relationship between the Parties. This MOU shall be binding upon executors, successors in interest and permitted assigns of the respective Parties. Any provision of the MoU may be amended or waived if, and only if such amendment or waiver is in writing and signed, in the case of an amendment by each Party, or in the case of a waiver, by the Party against whom the waiver is to be effective. Either Party may not, assign, in whole or in part, the benefits or obligations of the MOU to any other person without the prior written consent of the other Party. The MoU may be executed in counterparts, each of which when executed shall constitute an original, but both of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Nothing contained in this MoU shall be construed as creating any agency, legal representative, partnership, association of persons or other form of joint enterprise between the Parties. Neither Party shall have authority to contract for or bind the other in any manner whatsoever.





Memorandum of Understanding Agreement

This Memorandum of Understanding Agreement is entered into as of 16th August 2022 between BygC Solutions Private Limited [CIN: U74999KA2020PTC131375], a company incorporated under the laws of India and having registered office at B6, Sterling Villa Grande, Kadugodi, Whitefield, Bangalore – 560067 INDIA (hereinafter referred to as the “BygC” which expression shall unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include its successors and assigns) AND Placement Cell, KLE Society’s G I Bagewadi Arts, Science and Commerce College. Old P B Road, Nipani. Belagavi (District) 591237 INDIA (hereinafter referred to as “Institution” which expression shall unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include its successors and permitted assigns).

WHEREAS BygC is primarily engaged in the business of providing online and offline courses in various domains and generally offers their courses to those candidates who qualify the selection criteria;

WHEREAS Institution is an Academic Institution providing UG and PG Education in Arts, Science and Commerce, who could provide prospective Candidates for the Courses offered by BygC;

AND WHEREAS following discussions, the Institution has agreed to propose the Courses to Candidates and BygC has agreed to offer the Courses to the Candidates, as per the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS:

In this Agreement unless in consistent with the context or otherwise specified the following definitions shall apply:

- **Confidential Information** shall mean and include Content, Personal Data, results of any services, all materials and/or information including without limitation all BygC data, whether or not marked or otherwise identified as confidential, whether written, oral, graphic or ascertainable by inspection of tangible objects and any other subject matter which by its nature would be reasonably known to be confidential or proprietary, and all copies thereof.
- **Content** shall mean the learning material of BygC, whether in the video, audio, word, power point or any other format and also includes the materials/information generated by virtue of interaction between the Candidate and personnel/faculty of BygC.



- **Courses** shall mean those courses offered by BygC which shall be communicated from time to time by BygC with the Institution.
- **Intellectual Property Rights or IPR:** means all trade secrets, patents and patent applications, trade marks (whether registered or unregistered and including any goodwill accrued to such trade marks), service marks, trade names, business names, internet domain names, e-mail addresses, copyrights (including rights in computer software), moral rights, database rights, design rights, rights in know-how, rights in confidential information, rights in inventions (whether patentable or not) and all other intellectual property and proprietary rights (whether registered or unregistered, and any application for the foregoing), and all other equivalent or similar rights which may subsist anywhere in the world.
- **“Party”** means BygC or Institution severally and **“Parties”** means BygC and Institution collectively.
- **Candidates** shall mean the candidates proposed by Institution to BygC for the Courses, who have cleared the selection criteria and who have joined the Courses after making required payment to BygC.

REFERRAL AND SELECTION PROCESS:

- The Institution hereby agrees to introduce the Courses to the Candidates including alumni, so as to generate interest in them to join the Courses. The Institution shall inform BygC, in writing, with the list of prospective Candidates with details, once the Courses are introduced to them.
- On receipt of such list from the Institution, BygC shall conduct basic course counselling for them and offer them an evaluation process to see whether they qualify to join for the Courses.
- BygC shall offer the Courses to those Candidates who have qualified such evaluation process.

IMPARTING COURSES:

- BygC shall, impart the Courses to those Candidates who have joined the program after making requisite payments to BygC. The Courses will be imparted in accordance with the standard teaching procedure and methodology of BygC.



REVENUE SHARE AND PAYMENT TERMS:

If BygC is required by law to make any deduction or withholding from any payment due hereunder, then BygC shall deduct and pay such amounts to the statutory authority within the prescribed time and shall provide the Institution with a certificate to such effect.

WARRANTY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:

- Each Party represents and warrants that they have the right, power and authority to enter into this Agreement and duly perform its duties hereunder.
- BygC may make all commercially reasonable efforts to provide placement support to the Candidates who have successfully completed the Courses and where such support is mentioned as part of the said course program. Such support shall be in accordance with the placement policy of BygC. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, BygC expressly disclaims any guarantee to provide placements to any Student.

TERM AND TERMINATION:

GENERAL:

- Each party shall keep confidential all Confidential Information received from other party under this Agreement and shall not disclose such Confidential Information to any third parties without the prior written permission of the disclosing party or use them other than for the purposes specifically permitted under this Agreement. The confidentiality obligations herein shall survive the expiry or termination of the Agreement.

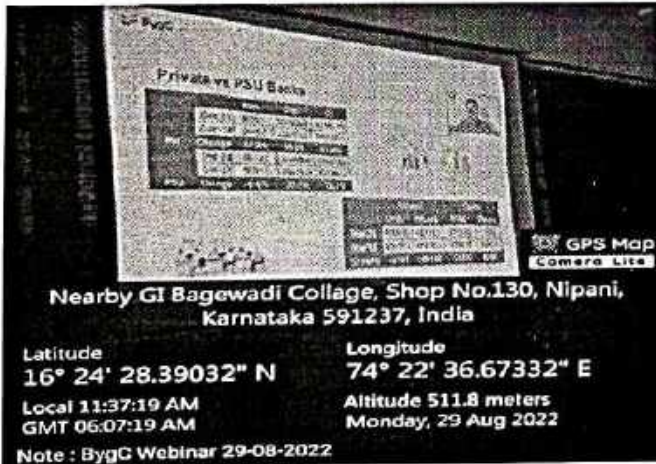

Dr. Atulkumar Kamble delivered a lecture on soil and water analysis and elaborated pH of water and soil and improvement of the fertility of soil.







In the 1970s, the value distribution theory of meromorphic function is expanded to the vector-valued meromorphic function from the complex plane \mathbb{C} to a finite dimensional space \mathbb{C}^n (see Ziegler [25]). After that, some works related to vector-valued meromorphic function in finite dimensional spaces were done by several authors ([4]-[6],[7]-[19]). C. G. Hu and Q. J. Hu [2] investigated Nevanlinna's first and second fundamental theorems for an E-valued meromorphic function from the disk to infinite-dimensional Banach spaces E with a Schauder basis. Bhoosnurmath and Pujari [1] established some interesting results for the E-valued Borel exceptional values of meromorphic functions, Wu and Xuan [21, 22] proved remarkable results on the characteristic functions, exceptional values, and deficiency of E-valued meromorphic function, and Hu [3] proved the advancements of the Nevanlinna theory of E-valued meromorphic functions and studied its related Paley problems.

2. The Value Distribution Theory on Banach Spaces

Nevanlinna theory for E-valued meromorphic function will play a key role in the proof of theorems. We shall use standard notations of value distribution theory for E-valued meromorphic function, $V(a, \infty, f)$, $V(a, f)$, $m(r, f)$, $N(r, f)$, $\bar{N}(r, f)$, $T(r, f)$, ... ([1]-[6], [20]-[25]).

Let $f(z)$ be a nonconstant E-valued meromorphic function of compact projection in $\mathbb{C}_R = \{|z| < R\}$, $0 < R \leq \infty$. then for $0 < r < R$ and $a_k \in E$ ($k = 1, 2, \dots, q$) be $q \geq 3$ distinct points. NEVANLINNA'S FIVE-VALUE THEOREM FOR DERIVATIVES OF MEROMORPHIC FUNCTIONS IN AN ANGULAR DOMAIN

In this paper, we first obtain the famous Xiong Inequality for meromorphic functions in an angular domain and also generalise Nevanlinna's five-value theorem for derivatives of meromorphic functions by considering weaker assumptions of sharing five values and small functions to partially sharing $k(\geq 5)$ values and small functions in an angular domain. As a particular cases of our results, we deduce He Ping result in an angular domain.

1. Introduction

The uniqueness theory of meromorphic functions is an interesting problem in the value distribution theory. We say that f and \hat{f} share the value a CM (counting multiplicities) if f and \hat{f} have the same a -points with the same multiplicity and if f and \hat{f} share the value a IM (ignoring multiplicities) if we do not consider the multiplicities. In 1929, R. Nevanlinna proved that, if f and \hat{f} be two non-constant meromorphic functions in \mathbb{C} and if they share five distinct values IM, then $f \equiv \hat{f}$; if they share four distinct values CM, then f is a Mobius transformation of \hat{f} . After this work, many authors proved several results on uniqueness of meromorphic functions concerning shared values in the complex plane. In 2004, J. H. Zheng (see [3]) extended the uniqueness of meromorphic functions dealing with five shared values in an angular domains of \mathbb{C} . Also in 2010, He Ping proved some important results on the uniqueness of meromorphic functions sharing values in an angular domain (see [7]) and others have done lots of work in this area (see [3]–[21]). It is interesting to prove some important uniqueness results in the whole of the complex plane to an angular domain.
