**HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE:**

The KLE Society with its noble Missions of spreading education for the socio-economic growth of the people started in 1961 of an Arts and Science College at Nipani.

As a mark of gratitude to Late Shri. Ganapati Ishwarappa Bagewadi, who donated a munificent sum of Rs. 1,25,000/-, the college was named “**G. I. Bagewadi Arts and Science College**” in 1966. ‘Commerce’ course was introduced in 1977.

P.G. courses like M.Com in 2010 & M.Sc (Mathematics) in 2011. Further to make our students competitive to face the outside world 11 Certificate Courses introduced during 2016-17.

The Institution spread over 11 acres of land has the Main building with 26 classrooms, 9 Labs, common staff room, Ladies room, Office and Auditorium Hall.
